2. Registration

Team registration will take place in the Race Office, located at Hemus Hotel, starting on Friday, December 21st, from 10.00 to 21.00.

3. Accommodation

As per FIS rule on accommodation and half board, each participant will pay CHF 50/day/person directly to the Organizing Committee FIS World Cup Sofia. Accommodation at FIS rate will be provided for the nights of December 21st to December 23rd 2007 in Hemus Hotel – www.hemushotels.com. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay.

4. Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation to Sofia. The Organizing Committee will organize transport from Sofia Airport to Hemus Hotel and back only for those teams, who have completed the enclosed Transportation request form and sent it back not later than **Thursday, November 22nd, 2007**.



Also transportation from Hemus Hotel to the venue will be provided by the OC for all teams.

5. Meals

Breakfast and dinner will be organized at Hemus Hotel, starting with dinner on Friday, December 21st, up to and including breakfast on Sunday, December 23rd, 2007.

During the event the Organizing Committee will organize lunch for the competitors and coaches at the Catering stand at the Big Air venue.

6. Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during all official trainings, competition and award ceremony.

7. Accident Insurance

Each competitor must have his own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers, Sofia Municipality, the FIS and Bulgarian Ski Federation decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

8. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers, Sofia Municipality, the FIS and Bulgarian Ski Federation shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

9. Official Notice Board

The official Notice Board will be located at the race office at Hemus Hotel and at the Big Air venue.

10. Training

Training is scheduled only on the competition day in advance of every heat and before the finals.

The prize-winners receive the net prize money in the Race Office at Hemus Hotel.
